



2024 NMAA State Tennis Championships presented by Corley's Albuquerque Lincoln

Class 5A

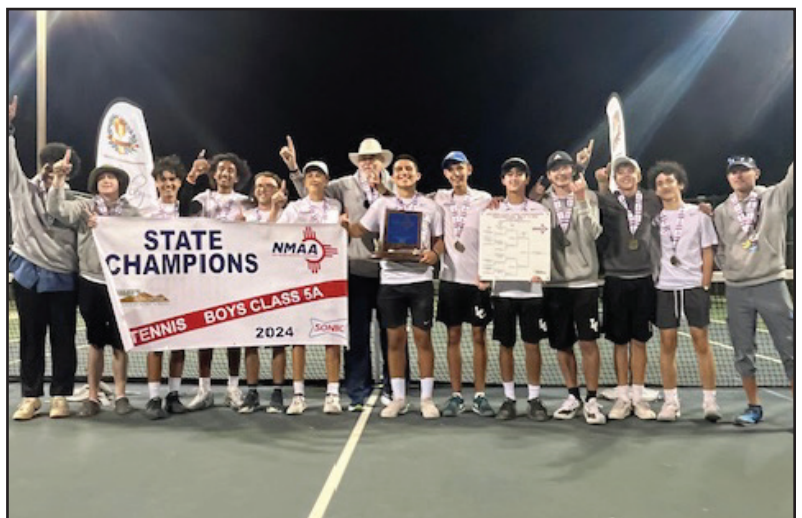
Girls

Eldorado junior Vivica Corley outlasted two-time state champion Cameron King of La Cueva in an epic final 7-5, 2-6, 7-6 (5) to win the Class 5A Individual State Title at the NMAA State Tennis Championships presented by Corley's Albuquerque Lincoln. Corley was down 1-4 in the third set, but outlasted King in the match that lasted almost three-and-a-half hours. Farmington's Marley Deswood won third place with a 6-3, 6-3 victory over Ellise Jay of Mayfield. Eldorado's doubles team of Vianca Corley/ Addison Arndt beat La Cueva's duo of Kendall King/ Alexis Spindler 6-2, 6-1 to win the state doubles title. Santa Fe's Carmen Valentino/ Yasmin Verastegue-Palomino beat Alamogordo's Evony Lopez/ Eva Westover 6-1, 6-1 to finish third. Top seed La Cueva took home the girls team title beating Farmington in the final by a 5-1 score. It's the third straight state title for La Cueva.



Boys

Albuquerque High senior and top seed Leo Rocca capped off his final year of high school tennis with a state title. Rocca beat Jaime Moran in the final by a 6-0, 6-0 score. It's Rocca's first state title after finishing second and third the previous two years at state. Leo's younger brother Mitchell finished third with a 7-5, 6-3 victory over Albuquerque High teammate Christian Olson. Santa Fe's duo of Carlos Flores/ Humza Mahmood beat La Cueva's doubles team of Tyler Kim/ ThaajBhardwaj 6-4, 6-3 to win the doubles title. Jimmy Evans/ Isaiah



Mayes of Hobbs beat La Cueva's Linus Wang/ Cole Segura 7-5, 6-1 for third place honors. Top seed La Cueva won the boys team title beating Albuquerque High in the final by a 5-2 score. It's the 13th overall title for the La Cueva Bears.

Girls

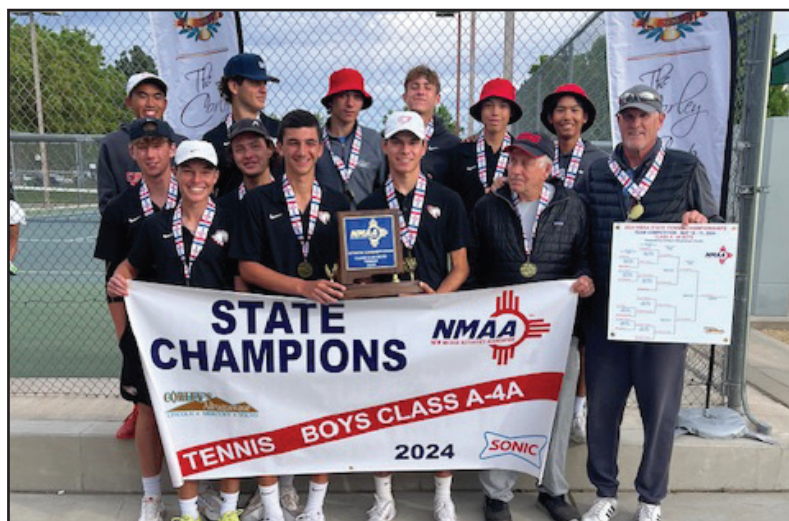

Boys

Albuquerque Academy remains king of the court when it comes to boys tennis. The Chargers won the state title for a 21st consecutive time and 26th overall at the NMAA State Tennis Championships presented by Corley's Albuquerque Lincoln. Albuquerque Academy won the team title with a 5-0 victory over Los Alamos in the final. The Chargers won all of their three team matches by a 5-0 score. Albuquerque Academy's Connor Dils took home the Class 4A state title at the NMAA State Tennis Championships presented by Corley's Albuquerque Lincoln with a 6-1, 6-0



victory over Ryan Sood of Los Alamos. The victory capped off an undefeated season for Dils. Albuquerque Academy's Abbott Carothers beat Deming's Sebastien Lescombes 7-6 (4), 7-6 (5) to finish third. Albuquerque Academy's doubles team of Adrian Hanna/ Austin Curtis beat top seeded Henry Kaufman/ Jackson Friedland of Santa Fe Prep 6-4, 6-4 to win the doubles title. Theodore Williamson/ Esteban Medina of Robertson beat Miyamura's Jameson Ferguson/ Sean Spolar 3-6, 7-5, 6-0 to finish third.
