



2025 Science Olympiad:

- Our Science Olympiad was held in person on Saturday, February 22nd, 2025.
 - All events, testing and builds were held on 2.22.25 across Tech Campus. Our awards ceremony was also held on 2.22, which was also live streamed for those not able to stay or attend due to traveling requirements. For the schools not able to stay, awards, and certificates were mailed to students, teachers, and/or schools.
 - We held check-in and registration at the Deju House this year – this was met with a lot of great feedback from participants, coaches, and volunteers.
- We had a total of **564** students that participated:
 - **255** B Division (6-8 grade)
 - **309** C Division (9-12 grade)
- We had a total of **39** schools that registered with a total of **60** teams Statewide, with **44** teams competing at State:
 - **24** High Schools (C division), with **31** teams.
 - **20** Middle Schools (B division), with **29** teams.
- Teams ranged from 3 - 17 participating students.
- We had a total of **23** events in both the **B & C Division** that we hosted, and students were able to participate in which included trial events.
- Students up to **10th** place received medals. Students were able to medal in trial events without affecting team scores.
 - Trophies were awarded to the top **5** teams in both divisions.
